WASHINGTON, DC - Then-Vice President Pence was getting on the phone with President Donald Trump the evening of Dec. 13, 2020, just as chatter was exploding on the internet that he could delay or block the certification of Trump's electoral loss to Democrat Joe Biden.

In his new memoir, "So Help Me God," Pence writes of how Trump told him during that call that he should decline to participate in Congress's certification of that vote if he wanted to be "popular."
