MADISON — Gov. Tony Evers and Lt. Gov. Sara Rodriguez today joined State Sen. Kelda Roys (D-Madison) and State Rep. Lisa Subeck (D-Madison) to reintroduce legislation this legislative session to repeal Wisconsin's 1849-era criminal abortion ban—a ban that was passed before the Civil War and before women had the right to vote and prohibits nearly all abortions without exceptions for rape and incest. The bill, <a href="LRB-0692">LRB-0692</a>, would cleanly repeal Wisconsin's criminal abortion ban, effectively reverting abortion access in Wisconsin to June 23, 2022, the day before the U.S. Supreme Court's decision in

Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization

that overturned

Roe v. Wade

and

Planned Parenthood of Southeastern Pa. v. Casey


