Once a center for rail and water transport, the Shipyard promises to return Green Bay to a prominent destination within the upper Midwest for recreation and tourism.

Green Bay, WI – The City of Green Bay invites the public and members of the press to a groundbreaking ceremony for Phase I of the Shipyard. The event will be held at 9:00 AM on Thursday, July 21st at 100 W. Mason Street in Green Bay.

Phase I will include the construction of a riverfront promenade, floating dock, fishing pier, habitat enhancement, and an accessible kayak launch. Construction of the second phase is tentatively planned to start in 2023 and will include a great lawn for concerts, festivals, and other events; a dog park; urban beach; adventure playground; and splash pad. The third and final phase will include a unique commercial plaza that will support local start-up businesses that specialize in food, beverage, retail, and recreation.
