GREEN BAY - In the early hours of July 3, the Republican-controlled Joint Finance Committee finished their work on the 2015-2016 state budget. The \$72 billion spending bill now moves to the full legislature for consideration.

The proposal siphons more public money to private schools, slashes funding for UW colleges and universities, erodes natural resource protections, degrades open records protections, and jeopardizes Wisconsin's model of care for seniors and people with disabilities.



Representative Eric Genrich (D-Green Bay), Senator Dave Hansen (D-Green Bay), and Representative Amanda Stuck (D-Appleton) will hold a press conference this Monday to discuss the state budget proposal scheduled to be taken up by the Legislature later in the week.
