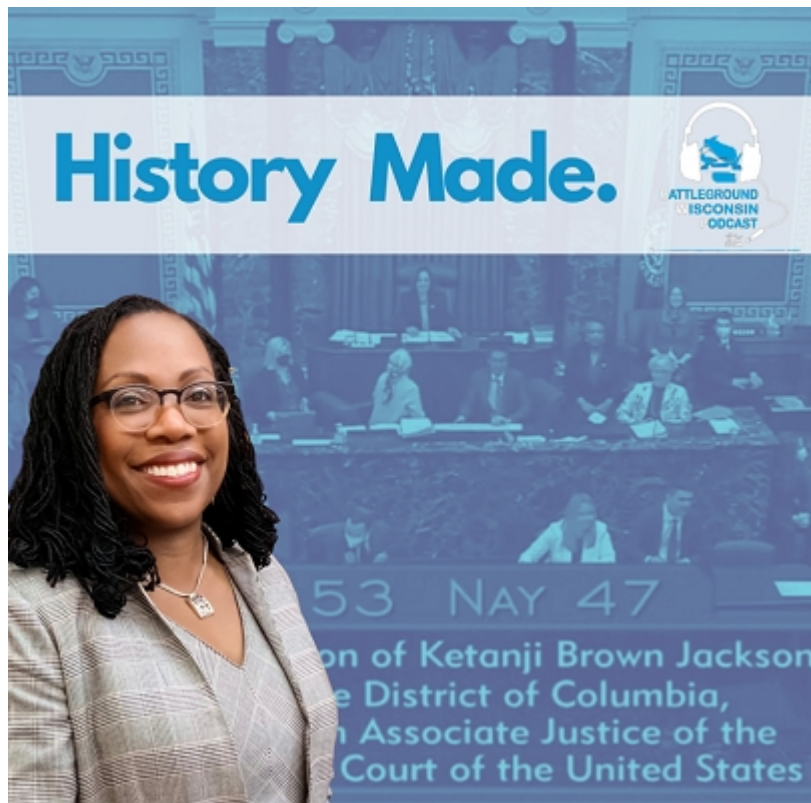


“History Made.” Battleground Wisconsin Podcast
