

MADISON – Tuesday, Governor Tony Evers appointed Sheboygan County Administrator Adam Payne to serve as Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR). The appointment fills the vacancy created by former Secretary Preston D. Cole's retirement. Senate Democratic Leader Melissa Agard (D-Madison) released the following statement:
