MADISON - The Democratic Party of Wisconsin today released a new web video highlighting Scott Walker's broken job creation promise to the people of Wisconsin.

As a candidate for governor in 2010, Scott Walker promised to create 250,000 jobs by the end of his first term. Unfortunately for Wisconsin workers and families, with only a few months left in office, Walker hasn't even hit the halfway mark on his central campaign promise.
