

WASHINGTON, DC - The Senate passed a \$2.1 billion Capitol security bill on Thursday, including providing new funding for the Capitol Police as they face a fiscal cliff, sending the legislation to the House.

The bill includes \$521 million to reimburse the National Guard, roughly \$100 million for the Capitol Police, \$300 million for Capitol security and \$42.1 million related to COVID-19 costs in the Capitol.
