Once again Republicans are putting partisan politics above people's health and safety says Green Bay Senator.

GREEN BAY, WI - State Senator Dave Hansen (D-Green Bay) said Republicans' push to end the Safer at Home Order is reckless and part of a larger pattern of callous disregard for the health and safety of Wisconsin families. Hansen's remarks came after Republican politicians came out in opposition to the Governor's decision to extend the Safer at Home order.



"No one likes having to make these types of decisions. Everyone would like life to go back to where we were before this pandemic," said Hansen. "But even under President Trump's own guidelines we are nowhere near ready to safely end the Safer at Home Order.

Hansen was referring to White House guidelines for re-opening the economy which state that before states can enter Stage 1 they need to show a "downward trajectory of documented cases within a 14-day period" and the need to have in place a "robust testing program in place for at-risk healthcare workers, including emerging antibody testing."

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
