

WERC decision goes against UW nurses.

MADISON – On Friday, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission (WERC) issued the opinion that nurses at UW Health can't organize a union and collectively bargain under current Wisconsin law.

Senator Melissa Agard (D-Madison) released the following statement:
