MADISON – Wednesday, Wisconsin Senate Democrats put forward an amendment to save the Child Care Counts program with \$340 in state funding. Senate Democratic Leader Melissa Agard (D-Madison) released the following statement on Republicans rejecting this amendment on a party line vote:



"It is shameful and wrong that Senate Republicans voted against this amendment which would have saved the Child Care Counts program. The loss of this funding will create generational harm for our state. Child care is a public good. "Over 2,000 child care facilities may close as a result of this loss of funding. Rather than utilize our historic state surplus to invest in our state, Republicans chose to turn their backs on child care facilities across Wisconsin."
