

MADISON, WI – In response to the Joint Committee on Employment Relations (JCOER) decision to withhold pay raises for UW System Employees. Representative Shelia Stubbs (D-Madison) released the following statement:

"I am deeply disappointed to hear that the Joint Committee on Employment Relations has decided to separate University of Wisconsin employees from other state employees when issuing pay increases and making cost-of-living adjustments. I stand by my constituents, Chancellor Mnookin and the University of Wisconsin, and will continue to support them in the legislature.



This decision affects twenty-four thousand University of Wisconsin employees and reflects poorly on the promise we have made as a legislature to those whose work makes the day-to-day operations of our university system possible. In a time of record high inflation, delaying action and withholding pay increases for UW employees can only have a negative effect on those who staff our largest university, from instructors to researchers to dining hall and custodial staff.
